From the protected foothills of the eastern slope of the Kleine Kalmit and thus the earliest as well as warmest Erste Lage (premier cru) of the domaine that is cultivated on loess loam soils with high active lime content, the 2019 Arzheimer am Fürstenweg Spätburgunder 1G opens with a pure, fresh and spicy, intense and coolish nose of dark berries and cherries along with earthy, beetroot and leafy notes. On the palate, this is an intense, fresh and tight, very elegant and silky-textured Pinot Noir with ripe and elegant fruit intertwined with spicy tannins and a refreshing saline purity and phenolic grip. The finish is intense, pure and fresh, full of energy and authentic grip. It's a fabulous Pinot for a moderate price. This was fermented partly with whole clusters, aged in French barriques for 18 months and bottled unfiltered with 13.5% stated alcohol. Diam cork. Tasted in March 2023.
