The Pinot Noir vines for the rosé and sparkling base wine deliberately grown in typical cool climate locations to preserve the crisp freshness and fine fruity aromas.

WINE Fine fruit reminiscent of raspberry and strawberry with a hint of pink grapefruit. The wine is fresh, juicy but also spicy. It is very balanced and has a delicate, light rosé color.

VINIFICATION Some of the grapes are harvested earlier to preserve the fresh, crisp character of the wine, while others are harvested a little later to obtain riper, finely fruity aromas. Vinification in steel tanks, gentle processing of the grapes.

STORABILITY easy drinking summer wine

FOOD RECOMMENDATION A good accompaniment to grilled vegetables, salads with goat cheese, Asian dishes, crayfish, prawns or asparagus

ANALYSIS Alc 12,0 %vol, Acidity 5,5 g/l, Residual Sugar 4,5 g/l
